VIDEOS

The mission of ILGA includes promoting the diversity and strengths of LGBTI people around the world. Share your story of how your ILGA member organisation is working doing to make your community thrive, and why you have joined ILGA in our common struggle towards LGBTI human rights.

We are looking for videos that are 1 minute long maximum, so that they can better be shared and watched on social media. Need some video shooting tips? [Check out this tutorial on Vimeo](#)

When creating a video, it is better to **start with a prompt**.

You may consider these examples:

- Tell us about how your organisation started, and how it is supporting the local rainbow community
- Tell us about why you joined ILGA, and how we are empowering you to do your work
- Remind people that, if they are struggling, there is a community ready to support them
- You may also want to throw in some “happy birthday” messages to ILGA on its 40th anniversary!
